1. Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondents to regularize the service of the petitioner under 2023 Policy for Welfare of Adhoc, Contractual, Daily Wages, Work Charged and Temporary Employees.

2. Learned counsel would contend that regarding the claim raised in the present petition, a legal notice dated 12.12.2024, Annexure P-9, has been served upon the respondents, which has yet not evoked any response. He, on instructions, prays that a direction be given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection.

3. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to

the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 12.12.2024, Annexure P-9, within a period of 4 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to him and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to his interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioner shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
