1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short-‘BNSS’) for quashing of FIR No.14 dated 07.02.2025, under Sections 140(3), 191(3), 190, 61(2) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana, Police District Police Commissionertate, District Ludhiana and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 17.04.2025 (Annexure P-2) whereby the petitioners claim to have settled their differences with respondent Nos.2 & 3.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the FIR is an outcome of a misunderstanding between the parties and with the intervention of respectable members of the society, the matter has now been compromised. He has placed on record the original compromise deed dated 04.04.2025 qua the compromise effected between the parties and the affidavits of respondents No.2 & 3 in Court, which are taken on record.

3. Issue notice to the respondents.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Manveer Singh Toor, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1.
5. Mr. P.K.S. Phoolka, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 & 3 and has filed the memorandum of appearance in the Court which is taken on record. He confirms the factum of the compromise having been effected between the parties and states that they have no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.
6. In that view of the matter, even if this case is taken to its logical conclusion, it would only be an exercise in futility as the parties have already settled their differences. Therefore, no purpose would be served in wasting the time and resources of the State in pursuing this case to its pre-ordained end. It would, therefore, be better to give a quietus to the issue at this stage.
7. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and FIR No.14 dated 07.02.2025, under Sections 140(3), 191(3), 190, 61(2) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana, Police District Police Commissionertate, District Ludhiana and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners shall stand quashed.
