RUPINDERJIT CHAHAL, J. (ORAL)

Through the instant petition filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (For short "BNSS"), the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.62 dated 19.03.2025 under Sections 109, 118(1), 115(2), 351(2), 126(2), 191(3), 190 BNS, registered at Police Station Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that in compliance of the order dated 24.04.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

3. On 24.04.2025, following order had been passed: -

“ Short reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur, has been filed in Court, which is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Adjourned to 05.08.2025.



Meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation and appear before the investigating agency as and when called upon to do so. In the event of their arrest, they shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS/438(2) Cr.P.C.

4. Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar, has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 24.04.2025 is made absolute. The petitioners shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
