SHALINI SINGH NAGPAL J. (Oral)

1. Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case arising out of FIR No. 23 dated 18.06.2025, under Sections 316(2) and 85 Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, Police Station Sadar Women Cell, District Patiala. This is the first petition for anticipatory bail.

2. Vide order dated 15.09.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

5. Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Puneet Singh Chahal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, PBI/Crime against Women and Children, District Patiala and on instructions from ASI Tejinder Singh submits that petitioner has joined investigation but has not got recovered one gold ear-ring and one silver bracelet. Learned counsel for the complainant also opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Benefit of anticipatory bail cannot be declined only for the reason that entire recovery has not been effected. Considering all relevant facts and circumstances of the case, but without commenting on merits, the petition is allowed and order
