1. The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.269 dated 11.11.2023, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 307 and 506 IPC and Sections 341 and 325 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Nigdhu, District Karnal.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that the case was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, since the dispute was marriage against the wishes of the parents and the relatives. Now the parties have amicably settled their differences before the Mediation Centre. A copy of the settlement/agreement dated 15.02.2025

entered into between the parties before the Mediation Centre has been produced in Court today, which is taken on record. He further contends that the injuries are not on the vital parts of the body and the petitioners are in custody since 21.11.2023 and 22.11.2023 respectively.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificates of the petitioners, which are taken on record. He states that the investigation has been completed and the challan has been presented.

Learned counsel for the complainant admits the factum of compromise.

Heard.

In view of the submission of learned Senior counsel for the petitioners, keeping in view the fact that the parties have compromised the matter and the petitioners are in custody for over 01 year and 03 months, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
