1. Petitioners through instant petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of Constitution of India seek direction to respondent to offer appointment to them alongwith all consequential benefits.

2. On 17.12.2024, the following order was passed:-

*“Learned State Counsel has produced the copy of Memo dated 16.12.2024 and which is taken on record as Mark ‘X’. Copy supplied to the opposite side. Registry will tag the same at appropriate place.*

*However, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that copy of representation dated 25.10.2024 (P-19) was sent to the Director General of Police, Haryana as well; but no decision has been taken so far.*

*In view of the above, let needful be done by the quarter concerned, before date fixed.*
