1. Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C has been filed for quashing of complaint No. NACT No.8240 of 2018 dated 27.07.2018, titled as “Vikash Vs. M/s Piyush Infrastructure India Pvt. Ltd. & Ors., under Sections 138/141/142 of Negotiable Instrument Act, 1881 read with Section 406/420 IPC, 1860, pending in the Court of learned JMIC, Faridabad, Haryana.

2. On 14.12.2023, following order was passed:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that the petitioner has never remained as Director of ‘M/s. Piyush Infrastructure India Private Limited’, besides, even the ingredients of Section 141 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 are not there in the complaint.*

*Notice of motion for 21.01.2024.*

*In the meanwhile, proceedings qua the petitioner shall remain stayed.”*

3. Today at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since impugned complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments



Act, itself has been withdrawn by the respondent-complainant-Vikash vide order dated 11.10.2024. Accordingly, the instant petition be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
