The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.41, dated 04.02.2024, under Sections 467,468,471,420,411,120-B of IPC, Section 61 of Excise Act and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Murthal, District Sonipat (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders dated 18.11.2024 and 07.04.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
