Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for not complying the order dated 25.3.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-8227-2025 titled as “Kawaljeet Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others” whereby direction was issued to the authorities concerned “...to decide he legal notice dated 28.1.2025 of the petitioner (Annexure P-8), within a period of one month from today, but after hearing all the affected persons concerned and by adhering to the principles of natural justice.”



Learned Senior Counsel for respondent No.2-GMADA, on instructions, undertakes that a speaking order shall be passed on the Legal Notice dated 28.1.2025 within a period of four weeks from today after giving personal hearing to the petitioners.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present contempt petition may be disposed of.

Disposed of.

However, in case the needful is not done, as per the undertaking given by learned Senior Counsel for respondent No.2, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition.
