JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent Nos.3 and 4 not to compel respondent No.5 to release salary of respondent No.7.

2. The petitioner is an employee of respondent No.5 and as per impugned orders, Assistant Registrar and Deputy Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Gurugram have directed respondent No.5 to release salary of respondent No.7. The petitioner as well as respondent No.7 are employees of respondent No.5. The petitioner has no locus to seek direction to respondents No.3 and 4 to withdraw their order or direction to respondent No.5 not to release salary of respondent No.7.

3. The petition is misconceived. It deserves to be dismissed and accordingly dismissed.
