1. The present writ petition has been filed under Section 226/227 of Constitution of India for directing the respondents to pay the interest at the rate of 18% due towards the petitioner for the delayed payment of the retiral benefits till the date of actual payment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that the order by which the benefits has been denied could not be challenged in the petition, and prays that the petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars.
