1. The prayer in the instant petition is for seeking quashing of the impugned order dated 24.04.2025 (Annexure P-9) passed by the learned Judge, Special Court, Sangrur and impugned order dated 24.04.2023 (Annexure P-4) whereby his bail bonds have been ordered to be forfeited to the State in case bearing No.NDPS-77-2021 whereby petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender in FIR No.208 dated 10.10.2020 under Section 20, 22, 29 of NDPS Act and Section 42, 52-A of Prison Act, 1894 registered at Police Station City 1 Sangrur, District Sangrur (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the impugned order dated 24.04.2023 (Annexure P-4) has been passed without following the procedure under Section 83 Cr.P.C. He further submits that petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings.

3. Keeping in view the facts of the case, the service of respondent is dispensed with as it will delay the proceedings.



4. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the material placed on record.

5. No ground to interfere in the impugned orders dated 24.04.2025 (Annexure P-9) and 24.04.2023 (Annexure P-4) is made out and the present petition is hereby, **dismissed**.

6. However, the petitioner is directed to appear and surrender before the trial Court concerned within a period of 07 days from today at 10:00 p.m and may file bail application before the concerned Court. In case, he does so, the same be considered and decided by the trial Court concerned, in accordance with law, within a period of 03 days.
