1. None is present on behalf of the appellant. On the previous date, learned counsel appearing for the appellant submitted that he is not in touch with the appellant, accordingly notice was issued to the appellant and the same has been received unserved for want of complete particulars. It seems that appellant has lost interest in pursuing the appeal. Moreover, there is no document on pertaining to correct/complete address of the appellant.

2. Having regard to the above and considering the prevailing circumstances, the Court finds no justification to keep the appeal pending indefinitely on the docket. Despite repeated opportunities, the appellant has failed to pursue the matter. Accordingly, in the interest of expeditious disposal of cases and judicial propriety, the appeal stands dismissed for want of prosecution. Nevertheless, liberty is reserved to the appellant to seek revival of the appeal, if so advised, within a period of **three months** from today, subject to compliance with the applicable procedural requirement.
