[1] The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the impugned order dated 06.12.2003 (Annexure P-3), whereby the petitioners have been declared proclaimed persons in FIR No.527, dated 21.11.2002, registered at Police Station Sector-39, Chandigarh under Section 420 of the IPC.

[2] Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the matter has been settled between the parties as per compromise dated 24.05.2023 (Annexure P-4). He further submits that at the time of passing of the impugned order, the trial Court has not complied with provisions of Section 82 Cr.P.C. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that in compliance with the interim order dated

25.09.2024 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioners have joined the proceedings before the trial Court and they have been released on bail.

[3] Learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 6 and 8 confirms about the factum of compromise between the parties. He further confirms that the petitioners have joined the proceedings before the trial Court.

[4] Learned State counsel has also confirmed that the petitioners have joined the proceedings before the trial Court.

[5] I have heard the aforesaid submissions and perused the paper-book.

[6] In view of the reasons recorded in the interim order dated 25.09.2024 and in view of the fact that the petitioners have joined the proceedings before the trial Court, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 06.12.2003 (Annexure P-3), whereby the petitioners have been declared proclaimed persons in FIR No.527, dated 21.11.2002, registered at Police Station Sector-39, Chandigarh under Section 420 of the IPC is hereby set aside and interim order dated 25.09.2024 is made absolute.

[7] All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
