NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 19(4) of the Family Court Act, 1984 impugning the judgment dated 07.08.2023 passed by learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Rohtak, whereby the respondents have been granted interim maintenance of a sum of Rs.14,000/- per month along with Rs.11000/- litigation expenses.
2. While issuing notice of motion on 30.01.2024, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to pay the arrears of maintenance to the respondents in terms of order dated 07.08.2023 passed by learned Principal Judge (Family Court), Rohtak, and bring a draft in this regard on the next date of hearing.

Notice of motion for 01.04.2024.

Respondent No.1-wife, is present in person along with her minor son in Court today. She submits that she is



not earning anything and that she has not been paid a single penny by the petitioner-husband. On her oral request, Sh. Rajiv Joshi, Advocate (P/1585/01) present in Court is appointed as Legal Aid Counsel to assist the Court on behalf of the respondents.

The requisite fee/remuneration of the aforesaid counsel shall be borne by the High Court Legal Services Committee.

A copy of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day”

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the undertaking given on 30.01.2024 has not been complied with by the petitioner.

4. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has no instructions from the petitioner in this regard.

2. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
