This is an application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act to condone the delay of 21 days in filing the appeal.

Heard.

For the reasons as mentioned in the application, supported by an affidavit of the appellant, the delay of 21 days in filing the appeal is hereby condoned.

The application stands disposed of.

FAO-3322-2025

It is claimant's appeal seeking enhancement of compensation. Appellant was the injured. As per the Award dated 02.12.2024 passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Karnal (for short 'the Tribunal), the appellant has sustained simple injuries only. He remained hospitalized only for one day. All the treatment received by him was from the Government Hospital. There was no disability, temporary or permanent. The Tribunal has awarded an amount of ₹15,000/- towards pain and sufferings; another amount of ₹15,000/- for loss of amenities. Thus, total compensation awarded to the appellant is ₹30,000/-. This Court does not find any justification to enhance the compensation.

As such, present appeal is hereby dismissed.
