**VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)**

1. Present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for directing the Lower Appellate Court to decide the appeal dated 22.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner expeditiously.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had filed an application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC alongwith the suit, which was dismissed vide order dated 14.12.2023 (Annexure P-1) and against the same, the petitioner had filed an appeal dated 22.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) and on 01.02.2024, the 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Court had observed that there were arguable points in the appeal and accordingly record from the trial Court was called for. It is further submitted that after all the parties had been served, counsel for the parties

had addressed their arguments on 20.05.2024, however, thereafter the matter is being adjourned and has not been finally decided. It is stated that there is urgency in the matter and the case is now listed for 20.03.2025. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes that in case the matter is to be reargued or any further assistance is required by the Court, then, the counsel appearing before the 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Court would do the same on the said date or on the date which the 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Court would direct the counsel to do so.

3. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present revision petition is disposed of with a request to the 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Court to decide the appeal dated 22.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) filed against the order dated 14.12.2023, as expeditiously as possible, preferably, within a period of two months from 20.03.2025.

4. Counsel appearing before the 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Court is also requested to fully assist the Court in expeditious disposal of the matter.
