reply dated 05.02.2025 (Annexure P-8) against the complaint dated 17.01.2025 (Annexure P-5), the petitioner is not being allowed to join the course.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that either the respondent-University should be directed to pass an appropriate speaking order with regard to the future of the petitioner keeping in view the allegation alleged against him by taking into consideration the reply dated 05.02.2025 (Annexure P-8) filed by the petitioner against complaint dated 17.01.2025 (Annexure P-5) forthwith, otherwise the petitioner be allowed to undergo studies in the University till any fresh order is passed.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Nilesh Bhardwaj, Advocate, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-University.

6. Learned counsel for the respondent-University submits that the reply dated 05.02.2025 (Annexure P-8) submitted by the petitioner against complaint dated 17.01.2025 (Annexure P-5) is to be considered by the Board of Discipline which meeting is likely to be held within next two weeks.

7. Learned counsel for the respondent-University further submits that there is no restriction on the part of the University upon the petitioner not to attend the classes and in case he wants, he can come to the University to attend the classes subject to any order to be passed on the allegation by the competent authority but he should maintain the discipline as required to be maintained.
