1. Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, is for issuance of appropriate directions to the official respondents to register a criminal case against respondents No. 4 and 5, who allegedly trespassed into the house of the petitioners on 18.04.2025 and hurled abuses to them and also to decide their representation/complaint dated 22.04.2025. The petitioners have also prayed for protecting their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5.

2. Learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, in terms of a writing received from SHO, Police Station City Rohtak, has submitted that on receipt of the aforesaid complaint from the petitioners, thorough inquiry has been conducted by the police concerned and it has been found that petitioner No. 1 herself is an accused in FIR No. 177 dated 25.04.2025, registered under Sections 115, 126 and 351(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station City Rohtak and she had given aforesaid complaint with false

allegations. Hence, the said complaint has been filed. Learned State counsel has further submitted that during inquiry, even no threat perception was found to the petitioners or their family members at the hands of the private respondents.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners could not dispute the aforesaid facts.

4. Keeping in view the fact that the aforesaid representation/complaint moved by the petitioners has already been filed by the official respondents after conducting through inquiry into the allegations made therein and no threat perception was found to their life and liberty, this Court finds no ground to issue any direction to the official respondents. Even otherwise, the petitioners may file an appropriate complaint before the Area Magistrate for initiating criminal proceedings against the private respondents. Hence, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
