1. Prayer in this writ petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing respondent No.1 to decide the revision petition dated 13.09.2024 (Annexure P-11), wherein the petitioner has assailed the revised layout/demarcation plans dated 05.05.2023 and 15.11.2023 as the same are in contravention to the Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran Act, 1977, in a time bound manner.

2. On behalf of the petitioner, it has been submitted that revision petition dated 13.09.2024 (Annexure P-11) has been preferred by him

before respondent No.1 and the same is pending since long. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the said revision petition be decided by respondent No.1 in a time bound manner.

3. On the other hand, on advance service of copy of petition, learned State counsel appears and opposes issuance of notice of motion. He submits that grievance of the petitioner will be looked into by respondent No.1 and it shall take decision either way, on the revision petition dated 13.09.2024 (Annexure P-11) of the petitioner.

4. Considering the above and without commenting on merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to look into the matter and pass an appropriate reasoned order in the revision petition dated 13.09.2024 (Annexure P-11) filed by the petitioner, in accordance with law, at the earliest, preferably within a period of 06 weeks from the date of receipt of copy/ production of this order.
