The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the petitioners the benefit of five marks on the basis of couple case in the upcoming Online Transfer Drive under the Teacher Transfer Policy, 2023, dated 09.08.2023, Annexure P-8.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case respondent no.1 is directed to decide the pending representation, dated 07.01.2025, Annexure P-10, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Rohit Arya, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice and submits that the pending representation dated 07.01.2025 shall be decided by the first respondent/Additional Chief Secretary, Department of School Education, expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the first respondent/Additional Chief



Secretary, Department of School Education to consider and decide the pending representation, dated 07.01.2025, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, prior to the issuance of transfer drive.

6. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioners.
