Petitioner seeks regular bail in case vide FIR No.595, dated 27.06.2024, under Sections 377 IPC and Section 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, Police Station Palla, District Faridabad. This is his first petition for regular bail.

Complainant 'M' alleged that her minor daughter 'R', aged 10 years, informed her on 27.06.2024 that Mangat Singh alias Mangu son of Puran Singh, resident of Diwan Ki Dhani Chhayasa, Faridabad, tenant of Sultana Singh gave her Rs.20/- to bring milk packet and when she went to his room to deliver the packet, he took her inside the room, locked the room and committed wrong act in private area.

It has been argued by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner was in judicial custody in the case for the last more than one year; that prosecutrix was avoiding her appearance in the Court; that petitioner had been falsely implicated and had no concern with the incident.



Considering the period of incarceration, he deserved to be enlarged on bail.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kshitiz Bharati, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State. He places on record the custody certificate. The prayer for bail has been opposed on the ground of serious nature of allegations.

The case is at initial stage. Prosecutrix is yet to be examined. Allegations against the petitioner are of aggravated penetrative sexual assault on a minor child, aged 10 years. The crime alleged is against morality. Considering the over all facts and circumstances of the case the role attributed to petitioner, impact of such offences on the society at large, no ground is made out to release the petitioner on bail, despite the period of his incarceration.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.
