The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the benefit of additional ten per cent of basic pay to the petitioner in terms of clause 11 of the Teacher Transfer Policy, 2016 (amended in 2017).

2. Learned State counsel has received instructions from the third respondent/District Elementary Education Officer, vide memo dated 21.03.2025, which is retained on the case file as Annexure 'A'.

3. Based upon that, she contended that the petitioner was absorbed in the Mewat cadre after its formation in terms of Mewat District School Education (Group C) Service Rules, 2012, as he was earlier working as Classical and Vernacular teacher in Mewat district. Since he was never transferred in the district in terms of the Transfer Policy, there was no basis to raise a claim for additional basic pay in terms of clause 11 thereof.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to dispute the fact, nor has he been able to point out any averment in the petition to the contrary.



5. In view thereof, there is no ground to entertain the present petition and it stands dismissed.
