The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.142 dated 28.06.2018 under Section 420 of IPC registered at Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 13.09.2023 (Annexure P-2).

The learned State counsel at the very outset submits that the present petition is not maintainable as all the accused persons have not been impleaded in the present petition and the partial compromise has been specifically barred by the Division Bench while answering the reference whether the partial compromise is permissible or not.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of, however, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition after impleading all the accused as party.
