Present petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a Writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release Rs. 94,580/- [receipts dated 24.08.2013 and 31.07.2014 (Annexures P-2 and P-3, respectively)] with interest from the date of surrender, which was deposited by the petitioner at the time of allotment of flat under the scheme of EWS.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner would be satisfied, in case, his pending legal notice dated 27.02.2025 (Annexure P-5) is decided by respondent No.1, which has not been adverted to by the respondents till date.

3. On the other hand, on advance service of copy of petition, learned counsel for the respondents appears and opposes issuance of notice of motion. He submits that grievance of the petitioner will be looked into by respondent No.1 and it shall take decision either way, on pending legal notice dated 27.02.2025 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek reply by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider pending legal notice dated 27.02.2025 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner, and pass an appropriate reasoned order, in accordance with law, at the earliest, preferably within a period of 03 weeks from the date of receipt of copy/ production of this order.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
