These are petitions under Section 11 of the Arbitration and conciliation Act, 1996 for the appointment of an arbitrator.

2. The agreements are separate. The parties agree that the disputes and differences are liable to be referred to arbitration. As the agreements are separate, there will be separate references in each of the matters. Separate awards would also have to be passed. The parties are at liberty to make an application to the arbitrator for leading common evidence.

3. Mr. Justice S. N. Dhingra, a former Judge of the Delhi High Court, is, therefore, appointed as the sole arbitrator in each of the matters.

4. The petitions are accordingly disposed of.
