[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 26.11.2021 in CWP No.24050 of 2021 in case titled as Anoop Singh and others vs. State of Haryana and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.24050 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the respondent to look into the grievance of the petitioner as per representation dated 28.10.2021 and also by keeping in view the contentions raised in the writ petition by treating the same as supplementary representation and to take a decision by giving specific reasons as to compliance of Instructions dated 30.09.2021 and in case it transpired that any recruitments had been made in violation of the said Instructions, then an order be passed as to what action had been taken qua the erring official, found responsible for such violation, within sixty days.

[3] Copy of speaking order dated 01.07.2022 is already on record. However, none is present on behalf of the petitioner and for that

matter, none was present on behalf of the petitioner on the last date of hearing i.e. 12.07.2022.

[4] Learned DAG states that copy of speaking order dated 01.07.2022 has already been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

[5] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned DAG that copy of order dated 01.07.2022 has already been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 01.07.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law. Liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition, if cause survives.
