HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

Petition herein is, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus, for staying the operation of order dated 12.06.2025 (Annexure P-2) passed by the learned Deputy Commissioner, Ambala, whereby the petitioner has been suspended from the post of Sarpanch of Gram Panchayat, Mastpur, District Ambala.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the aforesaid order dated 12.06.2025 (Annexure P-2) has already been challenged by the petitioner by filing an appeal before the learned Divisional Commissioner, Ambala. He further submits that, along with the said appeal, an application for stay has also been filed; however, the learned Divisional Commissioner has not yet decided the stay application, and the matter now stands adjourned to 04.11.2025.

3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if time bound directions are issued for decision of the stay application filed along with the appeal. He further submits that the petitioner would also file an appropriate application seeking preponement of the date of hearing, i.e. 04.11.2025, fixed in the stay application, filed along with the appeal challenging the suspension order dated 12.06.2025 (Annexure P-2), before the learned Divisional Commissioner, Ambala.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Kapil Bansal, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State, and submits that in case, the petitioner files an appropriate application seeking preponement of the date of hearing fixed in the stay application, filed along with the appeal challenging the suspension order dated 12.06.2025 (Annexure P-2), before the learned Divisional Commissioner, Ambala, the same would be considered and decided within a period of one week from the date such preponement application is filed.

6. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned State counsel, no further orders are required to be passed in the present writ petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.

7. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
