1. Prayer in this petition under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.150, dated 08.10.2024, registered at Police Station City Khanna, District Khanna, under Sections 305 & 331 (3) of BNS, 2023.
2. Status report has been filed by respondent-State. The same is taken on record.
3. On 22.07.2025, the following order was passed:-

“Status report by way of affidavit on behalf of the State has been handed over in the Court today and the same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to counsel for the petitioner. Perusal of para 10 of the status report reveals that State requires custodial interrogation of the petitioner to recover the stolen articles and also to trace co-conspirators or receivers of stolen property.

At this stage, petitioner's counsel submits that petitioner be not sent to custodial interrogation, he undertakes to cooperate in the investigation for recovery of stolen articles.

Given above, petitioner is directed to join investigation on 28th & 29 July 2025 at 10 AM and cooperate in the investigation. To enable the petitioner to join investigation, his arrest shall remain stayed till the next date.

List on 19.08.2025.

State to file fresh status report after conducting the investigation.”

4. Today, on instructions from investigating officer, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 22.07.2025 and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 22.07.2025, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.

6. Disposed of.

7. Pending misc application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
