This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 12.3.2019 passed in CWP No. 6662 of 2019.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"Statement of Mr. Sahil Sharma, DAG, Punjab, is recorded to the effect that the matter would be examined and either the admissible capital subsidy would be released to the petitioner as per seniority or if the petitioner is found not entitled to the same a speaking order in such regard would be passed and conveyed to him.

In view of the statement recorded of learned State counsel, no further directions are required to be passed.

Writ petition disposed of."

Learned State counsel on instructions from Ravinder Singh Supdt. (Incentive) Department of Industries and Commerce, Punjab submits that subsidy of the petitioner has already been sanctioned and the same would be released within six weeks from today.

In view of the statement made above, the contempt petition is disposed of. However, in case the statement made today in Court is not adhered to, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition. In case the petitioner is forced to revive the contempt petition, costs may be imposed which would be recoverable from the defaulting officer/official.
