**SUDEEPTI SHARMA, J. (Oral)**

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for disobedience and violation of order dated 30.07.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-2066-2018.

2. The relevant portion of order dated 30.07.2024 passed by this Court is reproduced as under:-

*“ In view of the above, it would be appropriate to dispose of the present petition with the following directions:-*

- i) *State of Punjab is directed to ensure that whenever a complaint is made which reflects commission of cognizable offence, as FIR ought to be registered in terms of the law laid down by the Apex Court in Lalita Kumari's case (supra).*
- ii) *The provisions of the Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques Act, 1994 be followed in its letter and spirit.”*

3. Learned State counsel contends that short reply by way of affidavit of Dr. Pragya Jain, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot, District Faridkot has been filed on behalf of respondent No.3.

4. Relevant portion of reply is reproduced as under:-

*“4. That in compliance/recommendation received from the office of Deputy Commissioner, Faridkot and District Education Officer (Elementary), Faridkot, FIR No.21 dated 04.02.2025, under Sections 409,420,465,468,471 IPC has been registered against Jaskewal Singh, Dhana Singh Deol, Sukhjinder Singh, Rajwinder Kaur, Varinder Kumar Salhotra, Sudha & Nachattar Singh and further action has been initiated.*

*5. That petitioner had on earlier occasion had made number of representations to various authorities and same were dealt by different authorities at different intervals and since FIR No.21, dated 04.02.2025 already stand registered on recommendation/officer order of District Education Officer (Elementary), Faridkot, thus, details of earlier representations are not mentioned and deponent reserves right to file a detailed reply.”*

5. In view of the above, order dated 30.07.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-2066-2018 has already been complied with, as FIR is now registered. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the contempt is purged. Rule is discharged.

7. Pending application(s) if any, also stands disposed of.
