1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against respondents No.1 to 17 for disobedience of order dated 30.10.2017 passed by this court in RSA-4646-2014; along with certain other prayers.

2. The perusal of the file shows that vide order dated 30.10.2017 passed by this court in RSA-4646-2014 the court has already decreed the suit of the present petitioner holding him to be in possession. Therefore, if any person or authority tries to disrupt that possession, in violation of law, the petitioner would have remedy available to him in civil, as well as, in criminal law.

3. Therefore, this court does not find it appropriate to proceed further in the present petition. Hence, the present petition is dismissed.

4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
