The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the order dated 29.03.2024, Annexure P-9, whereby the petitioner's request for transfer from KVK, Panipat, to the University Campus, Hisar, has been declined.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in a difficult situation at present since his son, who was falsely implicated in case FIR No.365 dated 27.09.2019, registered under Section 379 of IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, District Hisar, has died. The petitioner himself, as well as his wife, have serious medical issues on account of their son's demise. Besides, the petitioner is on the verge of retirement as he is to superannuate on 30.11.2026. Accordingly, at this stage, he may be permitted to make a representation to the respondents and bring the aforementioned facts to their notice seeking transfer back to the University Campus at Hisar.

3. Learned counsel for the University contends that in these changed circumstances, in case any such representation is made by the



petitioner, it will be sympathetically considered and decided in accordance with law within six weeks of receiving the same.

4. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

5. Ordered accordingly.
