Main case

1. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Mr. Sarash Punia, ADFO, Sonipat, submits that the petitioner has been accorded the benefit of regularization and whatever financial benefits are payable to her shall be released within a period of 04 weeks from today.

2. In view of the aforesaid stand taken by learned counsel for the respondents, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present

petition.

3. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned Officer would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
