Present appeal has been preferred under Section 28 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (*for short 'Act'*) against impugned judgment dated 12.09.2017, passed by learned Additional District Judge, Patiala, vide which petition under Section 13 of the Act for dissolution of marriage of parties by way of decree of divorce, moved by the applicant/appellant, was dismissed.

(2) At the outset, learned Counsel for applicant/appellant, on instructions, submits that matter has been amicably settled between parties; therefore, he does not wish to press the appeal any further.



- (3) Disposed off as not pressed “at this stage”.
- (4) However, it is clarified that in case an occasion so arises, applicant/appellant would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.
