HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. As per learned counsel for the respondent, the benefits have been released in favour of the petitioner. However, the said fact has been disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner while submitting that the complete benefits have not been received.

2. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent, no cause survives in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of. Rule stands discharged.

2.1. However, the petitioner, if at all aggrieved, would be at liberty to raise his grievance by filing representation before the quarter concerned within a period of two weeks from today, which shall be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon, which shall be conveyed to the

petitioner within a period of two weeks thereafter and in case of any delay on the part of respondent(s), the officer(s) concerned would be liable to pay costs of Rs. 50,000/- to the petitioner from his/her own pocket.

3. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
