1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobedience of order dated 25.08.2021 passed by this court in CWP-15391-2021.

2. In compliance of order dated 25.08.2021, the counsel for respondent has placed on record copy of affidavit on behalf of the respondent No.1, which is taken on record. The Registry is directed to scan the same and make it part of the soft copy of the case.

3. The counsel for respondents, after going through the aforesaid affidavit, has submitted that the order, qua which contempt was asserted, has since been complied with by considering the grievance of the petitioner and by passing speaking order. No further action is required in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.

4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, if any grievance of any of the petitioner is left unaddressed, he will be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
