SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (ORAL)

1. This case pertains to the category of fully burnt cases of the year 2006. On the last date of hearing, since, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the appellant as well as respondent No.1, therefore, Registry was directed to issue notice to the appellant, respondent No.1 as well as their counsel for the next date of hearing.

2. As per report of the Registry, notice issued to the appellant has been received back with the report that appellant has since expired, whereas, notice issued to respondent No.1 has not been received back either served or otherwise.
