Prayer in the present second petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.42 dated 20.04.2025, registered under Sections 331(6), 324(5), 351(3) and 3(5) of BNS, 2023, at Police Station East Sector-26, Chandigarh.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and file an appropriate application for bail and the trial Court may be directed to dispose of the same in a time bound manner.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. If the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of seven days from today and files petition for bail, then the trial Court would dispose of the same expeditiously in accordance with law.
