1. Prayer made in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No.37 dated 21.12.2022 registered under Section 7 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Patiala, District Patiala.
2. Learned State counsel refers to the status report dated 26.04.2025 filed by Deputy Superintendent of Police, Vigilance Bureau, Unit Sangrur, wherein order dated 23.01.2023 passed by Deputy Commissioner, Sangrur has been reproduced stating therein that no concrete evidence has been produced to prove the allegations levelled in the complaint against the petitioner rather due to giving false affidavit, case under Sections 177 and 182 IPC has been registered against complainant Pardeep Singh son of late Gurdial Singh and the sanction had

been declined. He on instructions states that consequent thereto the necessary action shall be taken by them, within a period of 3 months, in view of which, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the petition any further.
