

RA-CW-136-2025 in CWP No.18110 of 2024

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the grant of arrear rather than waiting for the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, petitioners intends to make a representation, which representation may kindly be decided by the respondents by passing an appropriate speaking order.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation is received at the hands of the petitioners, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of *three months* from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioners.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present review application may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

4. Ordered accordingly.

5. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
