1. As per report of Registry, record is not traceable after extensive searches by the office of Deputy Commissioner, Sonapat.
2. None is present on behalf of the appellant despite case being called twice. Perusal of file reveals that on the last date of hearing also, no one has put appearance on behalf of the appellant, it seems that appellant is not interested in pursuing the appeal.
3. Having regard to the above and considering the prevailing circumstances, the Court finds no justification to keep the appeal pending indefinitely on the docket. Despite repeated opportunities, the appellant has failed to pursue the matter. Accordingly, in the interest of expeditious disposal of cases and judicial propriety, the appeal stands dismissed for want of prosecution. Nevertheless, liberty is reserved to the appellant to seek revival of the appeal, if so advised, within a period of **three months** from today, subject to compliance with the applicable procedural requirement.
