1. The present revision petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950, seeking a direction to the learned Family Court, District Sonapat, Camp Court at Sub-Division Gohana, to expedite the trial of the divorce petition instituted by the petitioner under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1956, titled *Sonia Moudgill vs. Parvesh Kumar*.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has instituted a divorce petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1956, against her husband on the grounds of cruelty and desertion, which has been pending before the learned trial Court since the year 2021. The grievance of the petitioner is that the respondent-husband is intentionally protracting the proceedings by filing one application after another in the main petition with the sole object of delaying the trial. It is further submitted that the petitioner-wife is presently 36 years of age, is still of re-



marriageable age, and is also having the responsibility of a daughter. Ultimately, it is prayed that an appropriate direction be issued to the learned Family Court, District Sonapat, Camp Court at Sub-Division Gohana, to decide the divorce petition filed by the petitioner under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1956, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.

3. In view of the order proposed to be passed, notice is not being issued to respondent as it would delay the proceedings besides entailing additional expenses to the respondent.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the material placed on record.

5. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned Family Court, District Sonapat, Camp Court at Sub-Division Gohana, to decide the divorce petition pending before it, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
