The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner for directions to the respondents No.2 and 3 to file the status report of the FIR No.63 dated 30.06.2025, under Sections 118(1), 115(2), 351(2) of BNS, 2023 (Section 118(2) of BNS added later on) and Police Station Kheri Gandian, District Patiala.
