Learned State counsel has filed the affidavits of the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar and Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) to submit that the petitioner has filed a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. before this Court, bearing CRM-M-25769-2022, seeking protection to her life and liberty alleging *mala fide* against two police officials. It is further submitted that in compliance with the order dated 06.06.2022 passed in the aforesaid petition, vide which, it was directed that in case the petitioner is required in any criminal matter, then an advance written notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. will be given to her, an inquiry was conducted and it was found that no criminal case is pending against the petitioner, therefore, no contempt is made out.

Since there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, the present petition is rendered infructuous in view of the aforesaid affidavits.
