1. Present petition has been filed praying for directing respondents No.1 & 2 to take action on the representation (Annexure P-4/T) of the petitioner as the private respondents attacked the petitioner and also pressurized him to withdraw the civil litigation pending against them and earlier also the petitioner filed CRM-M-50463-2024 and the same was decided on 21.10.2024 (Annexure P-2). Further prayer has been made for directing the official respondents for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the civil litigation is already pending between the parties and the respondents are threatening the petitioner to withdraw the case. He has further submitted that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has already filed his



representation dated 25.02.2025 (Annexure P-4/T) before respondent No.2, but no action has been taken on the same till date.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents at this stage.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Addl. A.G., Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 & 2-State. He submits that representation filed by the petitioner dated 25.02.2025 (Annexure P-4/T) would be decided expeditiously in accordance with law.

5. In view of the above position, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the representation of the petitioner dated 25.02.2025 (Annexure P-4/T) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioner from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by him.
