The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 483 BNSS has been invoked for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.1158 dated 02.12.2014, under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 506, 34, 420, 494 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sirsa City, District Sirsa.

Reply by way of affidavit dated 15.9.2025, has been filed by the State, which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel while relying upon the aforesaid submits that trial in the instant FIR has been concluded, and the petitioner though has been acquitted under Sections 420, 498-A, 406, 323 and 506 of IPC, he has been convicted under Section 494 of IPC vide judgment dated 24.04.2025, with the sentence of imprisonment being the period already undergone by him.

In view of the above, the instant petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
