KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. Through the instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 09.05.2024 (Annexure P-8), whereby, the petitioner had claimed for execution of sale deed in his favour with regard to shop No.48, Shyam Nagar Market, Old GT Road, Karnal, being successful purchaser in auction and complete sale consideration has already been paid.

2. Upon notice, today respondent No.2 has caused appearance through its counsel, who on instructions from Mr. Bal Singh, Secretary, MC, Karnal, submits that the process of execution of sale deed in favour



of the petitioner has already been initiated, and the exercise shall be completed within a period of four weeks from today.

3. In view of the undertaking (*supra*), the counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the prayer made in the instant petition, at this stage.

4. Accordingly the instant petition is **dismissed as not pressed**.

5. However, liberty is reserved to the petitioner, to revive the instant petition by filing an apt motion, in case the grievance still survives.
