The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 in case bearing FIR No.4 dated 05.01.2020 registered under Sections 379, 342, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 397, 201, 427 IPC added later on) at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 02.04.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 02.04.2025 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on

joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

Petition stands disposed of.
