Respondent No.2 is present in Court and states that he has been transferred to Gurdaspur and now is not holding the charge of the said post. Mr. Vinod Kumar, District Development and Panchayat Officer, Patiala, is present in Court in person and has filed a short affidavit and he states that the order passed by this Court has been duly complied with. He states that the possession of the disputed land has been taken by the Naib Tehsildar, Bhadson and Circle Kanungo on 28.11.2004 with the help of adequate police force and possession delivered to the Gram Panchayat, Kansuha Khurd.

In view of the statement made by the respondent No.2 and keeping in view para 6 of the affidavit filed in Court today, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Rule discharged.

Counsel for the petitioner states that private persons are again trying to taken possession of the land.

If that be so, it would be open to the petitioner to avail of the remedy in accordance with law, which would include revival of the present contempt petition.
